DUTIES:

In the Visual Information Specialist developmental position you will receive higher levels of guidance and oversight.

Some of the job roles you may perform include:

- Planning and designing a wide variety of visual designs and visual communications products for distribution via printed, internet or video products.
- Consulting with internal clients and external customers to develop original design materials through interpretation of the meaning of the information to be presented, points to be emphasized, relationships stressed, and sequence of presentation.
- Conducting studies to determine the effectiveness of developed visual products in communicating to the intended audience.
- Supporting video production, to include scripting, directing, shooting and editing organization video and audio training programs.
- Incorporating news, information, music, still and video images, and audio files into fast-paced video packages.
- Preparing video files for web streaming ensuring 508 compliance (Opened/Closed Captioning).
